Reception parents' session in Robins: 16.10.24 8.45am Year 1 parents' session in Pine martens: 22.10.24 2.50pm Are you entitled to Free School Meals (FSM): All children in KS1 are eligible for free school meals (up to and including year 2). You can also apply for income related free school meals if you are receiving at least one of the following:

- Universal Credit (you're eligible after you've got your first payment)
- Child Tax Credit
- The 'guaranteed element' of Pension Credit
- Income-based jobseeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Income Support
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on

To check your eligibility, please apply via the <u>Citizen Portal</u> or simply call 0345 155 1019 with your National Insurance number. In addition to receiving income related FSM, you will also receive support during the school holidays (£15 per child per week) and access to the Devon Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF) which provides free activities and food for children in various locations throughout the Easter, Summer and Christmas holidays. CLASS NEWS

Wrens and Wagtails have been exploring lots of autumnal things. We have been looking at the conkers and chestnuts. We have also been on lots of senses walks around the school looking at what different things feel like.

Robins have been very busy this week. They have been continuing to learn sounds and using Fred Talk to help them blend sounds together. Over the last couple of weeks, we have been talking about our five senses. On Wednesday we went on a sense's walk and thought about what different objects felt like to touch. The children came up with some fantastic vocabulary e.g. bump, soft, hard, smooth, cold.

Pinemartins have been continuing to learn addition and subtraction facts. We have learnt about number bonds and fact families. The children have worked really hard to write number sentences and know the different ways that we can make numbers. Well done Pine Martens!

Hedgehogs have been learning about melody and notation in music this week. We have been using the xylophones to follow notation to create a melody together. They have enjoyed learning to play the xylophone.
