In Read Write Inc sessions children in Yr 1 will focus on incorporating reading, spelling and writing tasks all linked to the book they are reading each week. Children in Reception are either on a ditty lesson or a set 1 B blending lesson. Please look out for our next parents



Next week we will be starting our library sessions. Your child will bring a class library book home each week on a Wednesday. This is a book that your child will have chosen to take home to share and enjoy together. Remember:

- Children being read to or with continues to have huge benefits even when they can read themselves!
- Encourage a variety of text types
- Talk about new vocabulary
- Ask questions to develop comprehension.

*In history this term we will be looking Rosa Parks and Florence Nightingale

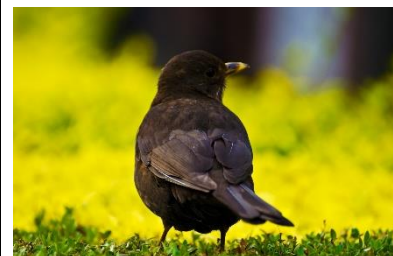


*In geography, we will be studying hot and cold places and the differences and similarities between their human and physical features.
